During the year, one child (Goutham) has been transferred to Chennai Snehalaya and one child (Vijay M) transferred to Shimultala School and we have also added four children. Three children had to leave Snehalaya due to various reasons. We have 31 children as on 31.03.2019 in three Snehalaya's.

Functioning of MILT Charitable Trust, Bengaluru

The trustees and active Miltonains meet regularly to discuss management of MILT Charitable Trust, Bengaluru. Financial plan for sources of funds based on requirement are planned in these meetings.

Functioning of Snehalaya Homes and other activities.

All the three snehalaya's are blessed with active administrators and miltonions who have taken up various responsibilities for the better functioning of our homes.

On 28th May, 2018 Spince has collected, Snehalaya 1 and Snehalaya 2 Govt. Licence from District Child Protection Officer Ms. Divya Narayanappa

New bank account has been created for Snehalaya 1, 2 & 3 and all Care takers are provided with ATM cards to take care of petty cash requriement. It helps the treasurer to reach the money to snehalaya on time.

Snehalaya 2 child-Goutham is Shifted to Chennai Snehalaya based on the CWC guidance because he is basically from Tamil Nadu and we don't have the rights to shift the children from one state to another state unless the parents are residing in the same District.

We have a dedicated volunteer Dr. Navya visiting snehalayas and doing the periodical health check-up for all the children.

NIOS registration was successfully completed for the year 2018-19 batches in the month of September 2018. With the Support of Delhi Public School Bangalore NIOS In charge Mr. Sherief and Painting teacher Mrs. Saritha helped us to submit the assignments on time.

Internet Banking: Online banking has made Snehalaya payments and other transactions easy.

Snehalaya 3 Counsellors organized half day training session for all the Snehalaya caretakers in Viajayanagar Snehalaya.

Dr. Murali (Dhanvantri Dental Clinic, Jayanagar, and Bangalore) provided free dental treatment for our 4 Snehalaya children.

Spince Jose attended the Pro-child Network meeting on 16.02.2019 organized by APSA and the topic was based on the child Beggary.

Dream India Network conduct CCI Meet in Christ University in collaboration with world Vision India and IPDP. Chairman C Grahadurai and Spince Jose attended the meeting and the chief guest was Dr. Usha who has been the new DCPO of Bangalore.

In the month of February 2019 NIOS registration completed for 10th and 12th STD boys for the year 2019-20 Batch. Early registration will help us to get the text books before the academic year.

Parents Meeting: We conducted snehalaya children parents meeting in respective snehalayas. A panel of Administrator, social worker, Tuition teacher and caretaker met the parents individually and discussed all aspects related to the children. The progress made by the children in academics, extra-curricular activities and other aspects of the child's growth are shared with the parents / guardians. It helps us to build good rapport with the parents and also they can understand the overall performance of the children.
